

R.W. BRO. RONALD KENNETH CAMPBELL

- Bro. Ron Campbell was initiated into St. Andrew's Lodge No. 560, Ottawa, on September 21, 1961, and was installed as Worshipful Master of that Lodge in June 1976.
- Ron was elected District Deputy Grand Master of Ottawa District 1 in July 1982.
- In partnership with the Masonic Foundation of Ontario, Ron served as Chairman of the Ottawa District 1 Project between 1986 and 1988, raising over \$11,000 in support of the Ottawa Chapter of VOICE for Hearing Impaired Children.
- In July 1988, Ron was elected a Director of the Masonic Foundation, and served as a member of its management team for 16 years. At the Annual Meeting in July 1999, he was elected President of the Foundation, a position that he served until the Annual Meeting in July 2004.
- Ron was appointed a Member of the Grand Lodge Board of General Purposes in 1990, 1992 and 1994. At the Grand Lodge Communication in July 1995, he was appointed an Honorary Member of the Board of General Purposes; and was reappointed for subsequent three-year terms at the Grand Lodge Communications in July 1998 and 2001, and for a further one-year term in July 2004.
- During this period, Ron served as a Member of several Grand Lodge Committees, including: Special Events and Regional Workshops; Mentor; Membership; Brother-2-Brother; and Blood Donors. Ron was also Chairman of the Grand Lodge Standing Committee on Long Range Planning from July 1995 to July 1999. Following his retirement from the Board of General Purposes, Ron has served as an active member of both the Grand Lodge Long Range Planning and Condition of Masonry Committees.
- Ron is the Grand Representative of the York Grand Lodge of Mexico, near our Grand Lodge, a position he has held since 1995.
- Ron is a Charter Member of Millennium Lodge No. 743, holding the Office of Assistant Historian, and affiliated with Luxor Daylight Lodge No. 741 in October 2002, where he is currently the Worshipful Master. In February 2009, Ron was elected an Honorary Member of Golden Isles Lodge No. 707, Grand Lodge of Georgia, St. Simons Island, GA, where Judy and he spend a portion of the winter.
- Joining in 1991, Ron is a member of the Ottawa Lodge of Perfection, the Murray Chapter of Rose Croix and the Ottawa Consistory, Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite of Freemasonry, serving as Thrice Puissant Grand Master of the Lodge of Perfection in 2001-2002. He was coroneted an Honorary Inspector General 33 Degrees at the 131st Annual Session of Supreme Council held at Toronto in September 2005.
- Ron was inducted into The Royal Order of Scotland in October 2005.
- During Grand Lodge in 2009, Ron was presented with the Grand Master's Meritorious Service Award.
